Under the overall supervision of the Country Director and direct supervision of the Deputy Country Director and within delegated authority, in collaboration with the other WFP units and WFP Country Office, national and international NGOs, Government counterparts, and other key stakeholders, the Programme Policy Officer will support the planning, implementation, monitoring and evaluation of WFP Food Security and Nutrition programme activities in the field office. In this capacity, the Programme Policy Officer will be responsible for the following activities/duties:

 Contribute to the development/establishment of programme goals, objectives and strategies and results-based planning through analysis of food security and nutrition needs and areas for intervention and submission of recommendations for priority and goal setting.

Review and give technical feedback on food security assessment, beneficiaries targeting
and monitoring plans and ensure that programmes are relevant, well targeted and
providing appropriate response to the food and nutrition security of the assisted
vulnerable population in Sao Tome and Principe.

Contribute towards the development of a wide variety of food security and nutrition, livelihood support, resilience building projects, plans and processes, ensuring alignment with wider programmes that complies with WFP standards and procedures.

 Participate in regional food security, nutrition, markets and resilience analysis and prepare timely reports on food assessment needs in line with wider VAM policies, processes and guidance to enable effective decision-making on the development of country strategy, policies and programmes.

 Provide project management support ensuring a coordinated approach with wider programmes and country office strategies and plans.

 Provide technical assistance and guidance to WFP Cooperating Partners to ensure compliance with the WFP's policies, criteria, guidelines and procedures.

 Strengthen the implementation on the field office monitoring and evaluation plan to ensure WFP's effectiveness of all food assistance interventions (e.g. beneficiary needs and status, food security status, programme modalities, implementation challenges, etc.).

 Develop and coordinate data collection and monitoring systems ensuring that rigorous quality standards are maintained;







 Contribute to the preparation of accurate and timely reporting on programmes and activities that enable informed decision making and consistency of information presented to stakeholders.

 Liaise with internal and external counterparts to ensure effective collaboration, monitor ongoing food security and nutrition programmes and highlight potential risks

to project delivery.

Support the identification, development and management of potential partnerships to

collaborative working leading to improved food assistance packages;

 Work with internal counterparts and external partners to strengthen the quality of food security and nutrition results monitoring and build credible evidence of trends towards the achievement of SDG2; play an active role in assisting the country to reach Zero Hunger.

 Seek partnerships with the sister UN agencies, national and international NGOs, donors, and relevant stakeholders; draft and manage Field Level Agreement and

Memorandums of Understanding, as appropriate.

 Build effective and collaborative relations with the national and local authorities and contribute to the expertise sharing and capacity building for effective preparedness and response to food assistance needs.

 Promote actively integration of nutrition specific and nutrition sensitive interventions among the relevant actors involved in the humanitarian response (Government, UN)

agencies, NGO, communities).

 Support the capacity building of WFP staff, partners and national government to prepare for and respond to food assistance needs, e.g. through providing inputs into training materials.

- Guide and supervise more junior staff, acting as a point of referral and supporting them

with analysis and queries.

- Perform any other tasks as required.

Educational Requirements

Advanced university degree (Masters' Degree or equivalent) in International Development, Agriculture, Agricultural economics, Economics, Rural development, Food Security, Project Management, Nutrition, Development economics, Environmental Sciences, Social Sciences or any closely related field.

Working Languages

 Fluency in English and Portuguese (level C) and intermediate knowledge of French (level B).

Essential Experience

At least Five years of professional experience in food security and nutrition programmes management, monitoring & evaluation, program cycle management and monitoring, or Programme Coordination in a humanitarian/ development context with UN Agencies, NGO, government or private sector.
