The USAGM São Tomé Transmitting Station (Voice of America) announces the following job opening:

Position Vacancy: RADIO TECHNICIAN (STP/BBG-620-07)

Duties: Radio technician supports broadcast operations at the USAGM transmitting station in Sao Tome (also known as Voice of America). The Technician is responsible for operation and maintenance of up to 600 kW high power RF transmitters and antenna systems. The station generates its own electricity and the Technician is required to work on high voltage equipment. This is a shift position and working hours will vary. This position supports 24/7 Transmitter Operations.

Requirements:

- Secondary School Education. Bachelor of Science or equivalent level technical degree is highly desirable;
- Level III in both spoken and written English;
- Must be able to work in a team.
- Uses computer and software programs such as, Microsoft Word, Excel etc.;
- Two (2) years' work experience in Medium and Shortwave Radio broadcasting electronics or a similar technical communications field is desirable. In place of experience, equal number of completed years of education at the college level in appropriate technical field of study will be accepted;
- Ability to troubleshoots electrical and electronic equipment;
- Familiarity with electronic test equipment;
- Background in HF transmitter operations, technical aspects of shortwave broadcasting, radio communications devices, digital electronics and telecommunications is desirable;
- Knowledge of workplace safety and rescue procedures.
